

THE FERRY SCHOLARSHIP 2024

Applications now open!

The Ferry Scholarship is funded by a bequest from the late Cedric Arnold Seth Ferry, for the purpose of promoting study and research in the scientific fields of Physics and /or Chemistry. Public Trustee, as trustee of the Cedric Arnold Seth Ferry Trust, intends to offer The Ferry Scholarship to students undertaking Honours level study in 2024.

Eligibility:

The Ferry Scholarship is available to students undertaking an Honours degree or an equivalent programme at Flinders University, University of South Australia, or the University of Adelaide in 2024. Applicants must be able to demonstrate financial need, be under the age of 25 years on 1 January 2024, and be an Australian citizen. Applicants must be eligible for enrolment in an Honours degree in 2024.

Qualifications:

Applicants must have obtained, or expect to obtain in 2023, an undergraduate degree majoring in Physics and/or Chemistry.

Stipend:

The allowance for the scholarship(s) will be determined by the Ferry Scholarship Board and could be up to \$8,000.

Selection:

Up to 6 Scholarship recipients will be selected by the Ferry Scholarship Board in early 2024. The selection is primarily based on academic merit and financial need.
